Application for a Travel Grant

Programme	Support for participation in the symposium for professional development
Type of funding	Travel allowance
Target audience	PhD students, research assistants and early-career post-docs who have no other means of obtaining travel funding.
Funding	A maximum of €250 per applicant but not exceeding the actual travel costs. In addition, the Paul-Martini-Stiftung (PMS) will cover the cost of hotel accommodation (bookings will be made through the PMS).
Application	To apply for the travel grant send an informal email confirming that you are eligible to apply, along with a CV that includes your affiliation. Send your application to andrea.sydow@paul-martini-stiftung.de
Billing	The PMS will reimburse expenses after the trip has ended upon presentation of the original receipts/invoices; it does not make any advance payments.
Deadline	Closes on September 15 th , 2026. The PMS will award 20 travel grants. Selection will be based on merit. The decision is final.
